
FIGHTING TO END HUNGER ONE BOWL AT A TIME

SUMMER LUNCHES & SNACK BAGS

This summer, CRS was once again proud to participate in a lunch program in Avon to make sure kids who are on free or reduced lunch throughout the school year have the same access to food throughout the summer.

Thanks to a collaboration between eight Avon churches, the Avon Board of Education, and a long list of generous community donors, a total of 80 to 100 lunches were provided each weekday all summer long!!

In addition to the lunches, volunteers interacted with the kids by playing games, teaching arts & crafts, reading and keeping the children current with school skills.

Another summer project at CRS involved the provision of snack bags. This is the sixth consecutive summer that we've been able to offer snack bags to our families with children in addition to their regular grocery distribution. Thanks to a collaboration of Avon Lake churches, we distributed to 521 children from 188 families. The bags were assembled by members of several Avon Lake churches and CRS volunteers from donations of specific kidfriendly items (i.e., canned pasta with meat, small servings of fruit, granola bars, macaroni and cheese, and juice boxes).
