

Background of The Human Resource Center & Community Resource Services

I facilitated a small group of humanitarian-minded women who were the catalyst for a social services miracle in Avon Lake.

Here's how it happened:

An agency called The Human Resource Center (HRC) was housed in the Folger Home on Lake Road from its founding in the mid-seventies until the Lorain County Mental Health and Retardation (LCMHR) levy failed a number of years later. HRC provided multiple community services including: counseling, emergency financial assistance, seminars on mental health issues (e.g., death and dying, marriage enrichment, eating disorders, emergency food and utility assistance). One major component of the HRC was their working relationship with the churches and others in Avon Lake. The staff consisted of a social worker with a master's degree (Laura Smith), a volunteer coordinator (Janet Doerr), and many volunteers. Psychological services were provided by outside agencies. HRC was a well-regarded social service agency serving Avon, Avon Lake and Sheffield

Lake. When the levy failed and HRC services were eliminated, the communities served were without community social services at a local level and the services delivered were greatly missed.

This continued for several years until a local dress shop owner in The Landings, Pat Mayr, gave me a call because I was a former HRC volunteer. She said, "I remember that you were involved with HRC. People come in and talk to me at the shop. They have all kinds of needs and don't know where to turn for help. You've got to do something."

I immediately made some calls to Ruth Dobosy, who had worked for Family and Children's Services, and some of the women involved with HRC. They had no money, no funding source and no building at that point, but people still needed help.

Slowly miracles started happening and people just appeared at



the right time. First, the small group of assembled volunteers met with a community coordinator housed at Troy Junior High School, which wasn't being used as a school at the time. She offered the group the use of offices in the school. The initial mission was to set up a hotline to answer calls from the community and connect them with a group of community volunteers that had been gathered and/or other County services. Efforts were tenuous at best, until a new Avon Lake resident named Cindy Crellin offered her services to give some continuity to the group. She had been referred to the group by the Welcome Wagon via Pat Euchner, a supporter and former board member of LCMHR.

Later, Cindy reached out to several of her new friends and told them she wanted to raise money by hosting a Charity Ball, which was hugely successful from its inception.

Eventually CRS defined its mission as a community-based resource bringing in multiple volunteers and staff to address community needs.

I served as president of the CRS Board from 1990-1991 and then returned to my work in communications and other volunteer work. I am delighted to tell this story because I got to witness, along with many others, a community at its best. People Helping People. Volunteers stepped forward at just the right moment, all with big and open hearts, willing to help where needed. Today this good work continues and now CRS is a well-regarded and supported community service agency in Avon and Avon Lake.



On-Site Food Pantry

Information and Referral

If it is determined that the services necessary to best suit an individual client's needs are outside of our own capabilities, CRS has a vast network of agencies and other support groups to use as sources of referral.

CRS serves as the Salvation Army Service Unit in Avon and Avon Lake and helps distribute their funds locally.

SEASONAL PROGRAMS

CRS sponsors a number of seasonal programs that are designed to help relieve the burden on families during times that often bring additional expenses. These programs include our Holiday Assistance program in December, our Mother's Day Women of Worth program, Thanksgiving and Easter food baskets, and our Back-to-School Readiness Program.





Bid: Upon receipt of your welcome text message, click the BLUE link in the text to view your personal bidding page. Select any item to view it's description and place a bid.

Auto Bid: To have the Give Smart System automatically bid for you, select AUTO, enter the amount you wish to bid up to, then select BID. The system will bid incrementally up to your designated amount only if someone bids against you.
